### WHO?

Any registered Wolf, Bear, Webelos or Tiger who has completed their first year.

### WHAT?

Cub Scout Day Camp is four days of outdoor adventure and fun with: SWIMMING, ARCHERY\*, BBs\*, WOODCRAFT, SPORTS, GAMES, SCOUT SKILLS! Webelos and a parent/chaperone may camp out on Thursday night!

*\*Shooting sports are rigorously controlled with set standards issued by BSA.*

### COST?

Earlybird Registration is **\$75** before May 1, 2008.

Registration is **\$95** from May 2 to May 23, 2008.

Late Registration is **\$115** from May 24, 2008 to June 5, 2008.

No registrations accepted after June 5, 2008.

**\$20 discount** for 4 day volunteers! (may split time between parents).

### HOW?

Turn in all Registration forms and registration fees to *your Pack Day Camp Coordinator*.

### WE NEED YOU!

Thanks to our all volunteer staff, we keep Day Camp costs low. But each Pack must do their part and **send an adult volunteer for each three Scouts registered every day and a volunteer for both set-up and tear-down**. Most volunteers accompany their son to each activity throughout the day and you get a **\$20 discount** on registration if you volunteer all four days (may split time between parents). Youth over 14 years of age that have completed the 8<sup>th</sup> grade may also volunteer.

### SIBLING CAMP?

On the days that you volunteer, scout siblings ages 2 to 14 may attend our Sibling Camp for a one time fee of \$10. Sibling Camp participants must be potty trained.

### WHAT TO BRING?

Bring the following *labeled* items to camp each day: non-perishable lunch, full water bottle, sunscreen, Camp T-shirt (given out at pre-registration), cap or brimmed hat, comfortable shoes and socks, towel and swimsuit (most Scouts wear theirs to camp), day pack or book bag to hold everything, and Cub Scout Spirit.
